3. E-Travel : You must register within 72 hours of your departure time, and your e-Travel QR code will be used as your arrival card and customs baggage declaration form. Therefore, you must write your name and passport number exactly as it appears on your passport.

**Bohol Day Tour**

Experience the wonders of pristine nature on Bohol Island, the 8th largest of 7,107 islands. It was named Chocolate Hill because its shape and color resemble chocolate.

The tarsius monkey, a world-famous protected species and the palm-sized star of Bohol.

The Loboc (Loai) River tour includes a boat ride through the rainforest, meals on board, and a visit to an indigenous village.

You can experience an unforgettable trip to experience the mysterious ecology of Mother Nature in Bohol, which has not yet been visited by humans.

**Bohol City Tour**

**Bohol National Museum** - National Museum where you can see the history of Bohol

The National Museum, built in a renovated old provincial council building, is small in size but provides insight into Bohol's history. On the first floor, there is a private collection of Napoleon Abueva, known as the 'father of modern Philippine sculpture', and the restoration process of the cathedral after the 2013 Bohol Island earthquake is on display. On the second floor, you can see the formation process of Bohol Island, the army during the Spanish occupation, and portraits of revolutionaries who started the revolution.

※ Bohol National Museum is closed every Monday. It may also be closed on local public holidays and commemoration days, and museum tours are not available on closed days. On closed days, the itinerary will be replaced with a Panglao Cathedral tour.



**Baclayon Church** - One of the oldest cathedrals in the Philippines

Baclayon Cathedral, built by Spanish missionaries in 1595, has about 400 years of history. The

buildings were built over many years, and the white building is said to be made from a mixture of coral powder and egg white. Precious antiques and religious relics from the 16th century are on display, and it was designated a Bohol National Treasure in 1995.

✘ The interior of Baclayon Cathedral is not available for viewing every Tuesday or when there are special events such as mass, weddings, or funerals. (You can visit the outside of the cathedral) Additionally, when visiting the inside of the cathedral, entry may be restricted if you wear sleeveless clothing, short pants, or slippers.



### **Blood Compact** - The first friendship treaty between Europe and Asia

This monument was built to commemorate the first friendship treaty signed in 1565 between the Spanish governor Legazpi and Sikatuna, the chief of Bohol Island. It is said that the treaty was signed by cutting each person's wrist and drinking a drop of blood into a glass of wine. The Blood Pledge Monument represents this moment.
