Aqua Planet

Aqua Planet Jeju boasts the largest aquarium facility in East Asia. Aqua Planet Jeju, home to over 45,000 domestic and overseas marine creatures, is highly recommended as a family-friendly attraction. The highlight of Aqua Planet Jeju is the main tank, which contains 6,000 tons of water and 27,000 fish, and is a place where you can see marine life up close. This water tank facility is twice as large as Aqua Planet Yeosu and more than three times larger than Samsung COEX Aquarium and Busan Sea Life. What makes this aquarium event even more special is the Jeju diver diving performance that can only be seen at Aqua Planet Jeju.



Seopjikoji

Seopjikoji is so named because the island has a shape that protrudes into the sea. 'Koji' is the Jeju Island dialect meaning cape. Located just south of Seongsan Ilchulbong, this cape is a popular tourist attraction. From the top of Seopjikoji, you can easily see the beautiful scenery of tuff rocks, the sea, and rape flower fields. At the top of the hill, a 4m high and 9m diameter beacon tower is built using volcanic rock. Behind the beacon tower is Bulgeum Oreum, stained with red earth. The contrasting white lighthouse stands out at the top of the cone. Seopjikoji has been used as a filming location for many Korean movies and dramas.

YakCheonSa - Largest Temple in East Asia

Jeju Yakcheonsa Temple is the largest temple in Asia. It was originally a small hermitage called Yaksuam, but it was given the name Yakcheonsa because there was a famous mineral spring nearby. This is where the tombstones of two royal couples from the Joseon Dynasty, namely King Munjong and his queen, and King Yeongchin and his queen, are enshrined. Temple stays are also provided for both locals and foreigners.



Tangerine Experience

Jusangjeolli Cliff

Daepo Columnar Joints are stone pillars formed when lava flowing from a crater rapidly cools and contracts. It is characterized by a polygonal staircase shape. These stones are 30 to 40 meters high, hexagonal in shape, and line the coast for about 1 km. The constantly crashing waves are a highlight not to be missed.

Mt.Sanbang &Yongmeori Beach

Sanbangsan Mountain, meaning 'mountain with caves,' is a mountain where Sanbanggulsa Temple, a temple with a small Buddha statue, is located at the foot of the mountain. According to Jeju mythology, her grandmother, Seolmundae Halmang, created this mountain by throwing a stone from the summit of Hallasan Mountain. Sanbangsan Mountain, which stands tall at 395 meters above sea level on the southwestern coast of Jeju Island, is full of rapeseed flowers in spring, creating a picturesque landscape with Sanbangsan Mountain in the background.

Yongmeori Beach is a water-volcanic rocky coast formed by the accumulation of volcanic debris erupted from three craters under the sea. The coastal cliffs look like Yongmeori ('Yongmeori') due to long-term sedimentation and erosion. The strange cliffs created by the waves are spectacular. The coastal platform next to the sea serves as a promenade. On the way down to the beach, the Hamel Monument is erected to commemorate Hamel, who drifted here.

Jeju Traditional Market

Dongmun Traditional Market, which has a long history, is a representative market in Jeju Island. Along with the adjacent Dongmun Traditional Fish Market, it is the core of Jeju's largest permanent market, established immediately after liberation in August 1945. Originally Jeju Island's only permanent market and center of commercial activity, this place was relocated to Jeju Island. We sell a variety of products, including vegetables, fruits, seafood, herbs, grains, and clothing.

Cafe street with Handam Beach

Aewol-eup, located next to the beautiful sea of Jeju, is believed to have been named 'Gaddal' in the past. Goddal is a name that combines the Jeju word 'gat', meaning coast, and 'dal', meaning moon. It is said that Aewol Port originated because it resembles a crescent moon. Follow the winding curves of the Handam Coastal Trail that connects Aewol and Gwakji. In 2009, Jeju City designated the Handam Coastal Trail as one of Jeju's 31 Hidden Scenic Areas, and many cafes and restaurants opened along the trail. Today, this route is so popular that it can hardly be called a 'hidden sight' in good faith, but it only means that more people are discovering the charms of this beautiful route.



Jeju Arte Museum

Arte Museum is Korea's largest realistic media art exhibition presented by District, a global digital design company famous for 'WAVE', at COEX. The museum displays 10 of the most colorful pieces of media art created by light and sound on a large site with a total floor area of 4,628 m2 and a maximum height of 10 m, in a space that was once used as a speaker manufacturing factory.

Yongdoo Rock, Yongyeon Bridge

Yongduam Rock, located on the northern coast of downtown Jeju, is a rock estimated to be 10 meters high. It has been carved by strong winds and waves over a long period of time and resembles the shape of a dragon's head. There are many legends surrounding the rock. There is a legend that a dragon who stole precious jade from Hallasan Mountain was struck down by the mountain god's arrow. As soon as he fell, his body sank into the sea, and his head rapidly froze as he looked up at the sky. According to another legend, a white horse that dreamed of becoming a dragon and ascending to heaven was captured by a soldier and frozen on a rock.

Yongyeon is a place where sea water and fresh water meet. There is a legend that the Dragon King often sent envoys to the pond. There are eight rock walls that look like folding screens on both sides of the pond. This pond, also called Yongyeon Yabeom, is one of the 12 scenic spots of Yeongju. Yongyeon Beom refers to the beautiful sight created by the reflection of the full moon in the clear sea water of the rocky cliffs. So, many people come to the pond at night to see the beautiful night scenery.
