### Thailand Preparation Guid/ Preparations/Procedures Before Leaving Korea

Essential documents for travel, simple guide, immigration information, and details.

1. Passport validity of at least 6 months
2. Round-trip air ticket: Have an outbound ticket within 30 days of entry.
3. Single passport is possible (must check if used)



## Entry conditions and required documents for Thailand

### [Instructions for Filling out Thailand Digital Arrival Card (TDAC)]

All foreign travelers entering Thailand are required to fill out a Digital Arrival Card. (If you do not fill it out, you cannot enter Thailand)

#### ■ How to fill out and submit Thailand Digital Immigration Card registration

1. Access to TDAC website
2. Follow the instructions on the website and enter personal information, travel information, etc.
3. Confirm the input and submit
4. Check and download the file (QR code) received by email
5. Present the file (QR code) along with your passport to the Thai immigration officer

#### ■ When to fill it out It must be completed and submitted within 3 days before entering the country, including the day you enter Thailand.

Example: When entering Thailand on May 4th, fill out and submit between May 2nd ~ May 4th

#### ■ Notes

- Please bring the received file (QR code) separately (printed or captured) as the Internet environment may be poor during immigration.
- Immigration declaration is a separate system from visas, so it applies to both people regardless of whether they have a visa or not.
- There is no additional fee for completing the TDAC, and if your itinerary is postponed after submitting the TDAC, you will need to rewrite it according to your arrival schedule.

※ Please note that immigration procedures and contents are subject to change according to the Thai government and domestic guidelines.



#### **Ayutthaya Sunset Tour** - Watching the sunset in Ayutthaya, the ancient city of Thailand

Ayutthaya, the ancient city of Thailand, is a place where history lives and breathes. Ayutthaya, which means 'immortal', was registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1991 and was the capital of Thailand for 400 years until it was invaded by Burma in 1767. There are temples such as Wat Yai Chai Mongkhon, Wat Phra Mahathat, and Wat Phra Si Sanphet, where you can get a glimpse of the traces of the ancient city of Thailand, so it is recommended as a must-see tourist course near Bangkok. Take a sunset boat at sunset and enjoy the beauty of Ayutthaya shining in the darkness. You will fall in love with another charm of Ayutthaya with its romantic atmosphere and fantastic sunset, which are different from the daytime.

This is Thailand's representative floating market, always full of locals and tourists.

Damnoen Saduak floating market, located about 100km west of Bangkok, is a place where you can feel the traditional Thai atmosphere. The transactions between residents and merchants end early in the morning, and from the time tourists arrive, it becomes a tourist market. Even now, residents live in floating houses built on rivers connected by several waterways, and tourists can enjoy the unique experience of going on a boat to see the traditional Thai market and shopping.



## Maeklong train Market

The Maeklong market near Bangkok has a train that runs through the market. Right next to the market is the Maeklong train station, and it is crowded with tourists from all over the world who come to see the train that runs through the market four times a day. It is interesting to see the precarious sight of people buying and selling things on the rails right before the train departs, and it is also fun to see the merchants busy trying to start their business again as soon as the train passes. You can also see fresh vegetables, fruits, seafood, and souvenirs at a traditional Thai market.

Compared to other complex and crowded night markets, it has become a must-see for tourists because of its neatly organized stores. Although the prices are not cheap compared to other places, you can buy good items, and as it is a night market, as the night goes by, more stores open and lights come on, creating a beautiful view. It is also a good place to enjoy a late-night meal at the restaurants and street vendors located throughout.

## **Grand Palace(Palace of Chakri Dynasty)**

- Bangkok's largest tourist attraction, steeped in the grandeur of Thai history

The Grand Palace, the most visited by Bangkok tourists, was built in 1782 when King Rama I moved the capital to Bangkok. It was built in traditional Thai architectural style and is magnificent and elaborately decorated to the point that there is not a single place that is not splendid. The coronation of the kings of Thailand took place here, and the interior, decorated with gold, glass, and jewels, is just as splendid as the exterior. The Thai royal family is the pride of the Thai people and a symbol of Thailand, and the current king of Thailand is a figure who is revered like a god by the Thai people. Therefore, you must be careful about your attire when entering the palace, and any act of insulting the king is absolutely prohibited by law. The Grand Palace is connected to the Emerald Temple.

※ The Grand Palace & Emerald Temple are places where Thailand's national holidays and various national events are held, so there are times when general public access is restricted without prior notice. In such cases, the day may be changed or replaced with another schedule.



## **Temple of the Emerald Buddha** - A temple with mysterious beauty

Wat Phra Kaeo, also known as the Emerald Temple, is splendidly decorated with real emeralds and other jewels. It is considered the best among the approximately 2,000 temples in Thailand. It is located in the Grand Palace, the largest tourist attraction in Bangkok, and is beautiful from afar, but you can feel its beauty and grandeur even more up close. There is a 75cm tall Emerald Buddha statue that Thai people are proud of, and the King of Thailand personally performs a ceremony to change the Buddha's clothes according to the change of seasons. As it is the most important and sacred temple in Thailand, you must be properly dressed to enter.



## **Chatuchak Weekend Market**

- Bangkok's flagship market sells everything it can Chatuchak Weekend Market

Thailand's main wet market, Chatuchak Weekend Market, which is only open on weekends, is also known as JJ Market. It has the appearance of a typical street market, with open-air bars, food stalls and craft stalls. In particular, there is a market where artists sell their works, which further enriches the market's charm.

It is a representative market in Bangkok with about 200,000 visitors a day, including locals.



## **Lunch** - Savoy Restaurant



Savoy Restaurant is one of the BEST RESTAURANT designated by the Thai government in 2017-18, and is a famous restaurant that anyone traveling to Bangkok must visit.
