Lunch - Local food (Bun Cha set meal)

After arriving at Ba Na San National Park, take the cable car

Take the cable car to Golden Bridge first to enjoy the fantastic scenery, then take the cable car again to the top of Ba Na Mountain and have free time.

Bana Hills Theme Park - Da Nang's representative attraction, a theme park located on the top of a mountain

About an hour's drive from Da Nang city center, Ba Na Hills, located at 1,487m above sea level, is a cable car station and resort facility built by the French during the French colonial period. Take a 5,042m long cable car, listed in the Guinness Book of Records, and enjoy the magnificent view of Ba Na Mountain covered with forests. After about 20 minutes, you will reach the top. At the top, you can have a great time at the 'Golden Bridge', a giant hand-shaped sculpture and landmark of Da Nang, and the 'Sun World Theme Park' reminiscent of a European castle.

(1) Bana Mountain (Time required: approximately 4-5 hours)

- ① Free time at Ba Na Mountain.
- ② Enjoy the fantastic view of Ba Na Mountain from the cable car that is approximately 5km long to the top of Ba Na Mountain.
- ③ The temperature at the top of Ba Na Mountain is relatively low due to its high altitude, so we recommend bringing a windbreaker or thin long-sleeved clothes.

Breakfast - Hotel style

Marble Mountain(Ohangsan) - Five mountains made of marble

Marble Mountain is a group of five mountains made of marble and limestone, also called the Five Elements Mountains. Each peak is called 'Fire (火), Water (水), Wood (木), Metal (金), and Earth (土),' and among them, Water Mountain is open to tourists. Water Mountain has a wonderful cave and Buddhist temple, and the surrounding area is decorated with various Buddha and stone statues. When you climb to the top, you can see the panoramic view of Da Nang city and the sea.

You can quickly and conveniently go up to the middle of Marble Mountain by using the elevator. Get off the elevator, visit the temples and caves, go up to the top of the mountain, enjoy the view of Da Nang, and then walk back down.

Hoi An

Hoi An Basket Boat Experience

This is a traditional Vietnamese boat made of woven bamboo, and is called a "basket boat" because of its basket-like shape. You can take a boat ride along the Thu Bon River to enjoy the scenery of Hoi An and also watch a boatman's show on the boat.











Naewon Bridge - Hoi An's landmark

This bridge was built by the Japanese who settled in the port city of Hoi An in the late 16th century to interact with the Chinese. The area where Japanese and Chinese merchants lived was formed between the covered Japanese-style bridge. It is now a landmark of Hoi An and can even be seen on Vietnamese banknotes.











Guang Zhou Hall - A hall built by Chinese merchants in the past

The Guang Zhou Hall was built in late 1885 by merchants from Guangzhou, China. It is a combination of Vietnamese architectural style and Guangdong style, and enshrines the god Guan Yu and the goddess Thien Hau, who protects ships so that they can sail safely. In the past, it was used as a resting place and a place for transactions by Chinese merchants and sailors, and is currently used as a place for Chinese compatriots to meet and worship.











Thrnkey House - Hoi An's first UNESCO World Heritage Site

This is the house where the Chinese tycoon Turnkey of Hoi An lived about 200 years ago. It is well preserved as an 18th-century mansion, and was designated as the first UNESCO World Heritage Site in Hoi An. It was built using Chinese, Japanese, and Vietnamese architectural styles, and the interior of the house is decorated with gorgeous antique furniture and decorations. Uniquely, there are traces that show how high the river water rose when Hoi An flooded in the past. It has been designated as a Grade 1 Ancient House by the Vietnam Cultural Heritage Administration, and is currently run by the 7th generation descendants of Turnkey.











Phung Hung Hause - The oldest house in Hoi An

This is the oldest wooden building in Hoi An, built in 1780 by a wealthy merchant named Phung Hung to sell his goods. The two-story building is a Vietnamese-style structure with a Japanese-style roof and Chinese-style balconies. It is now used as a shop where you can buy souvenirs and handicrafts.











Dinner - Hoi An Home Cooking Set

The three most famous dishes of Hoi An: Cao Lau, White Rose, and Hoan Tan! Hoi An-style rice noodles, "Cao Lau," made with thick rice noodles, pork, and vegetables mixed in a homemade broth; Hoi An-style dumplings, "White Rose," named for the white rose-like texture of the rice dumpling skin; and Hoan Tan, a Hoi An-style fried dish topped with tomatoes, onions, minced meat, etc. Enjoy Hoi An's signature dishes and traditional local meals such as Morning Glory and Cha Cao while taking in the beautiful night view of Hoi An.











Hoi An Cyclo

The cyclo, a unique form of transportation in Vietnam, is a three-wheeled rickshaw. It is pushed forward from behind and moves slowly, making it a great way to see every corner of the old town. Take a cyclo ride around Hoi An and experience the true charm of Vietnamese culture.











Hoi An Night Tour

The night view of Hoi An, with colorful street lights and wishing boat lights at sunset, is enchanting. You can stroll through the old town full of exotic charm and have a special experience of floating wishing lanterns on the Thu Bon River. (Including boarding the wishing boat, floating the wishing lantern, viewing the night market, and one drink)

My khe Beach - The world's 6 best beaches with long white sand

My Khe Beach is a beautiful beach that was selected as one of the world's six best beaches by the American economic weekly magazine 'Forbes'. It has a 10km long, fine sandy beach. It is the representative beach of Danang, and is located close to the center, so it is a place visited by many tourists and also serves as a place of relaxation for Danang citizens. There are many restaurants, cafes, and pubs around, so you can enjoy a meal or coffee while admiring the beach.

Danang Cathedral(Pink Cathedral) - Photo spots in Danang, located in the heart of the city

This is a medieval-style Catholic cathedral built in 1923 during the French colonial period. There is a statue of the Virgin Mary in the courtyard of the cathedral, and because of its pink exterior, it is called the Pink Cathedral and has become a photo spot on Tran Phu Street. There is a rooster-shaped weather vane on top of the 70-meter-high spire, so it is also called the Rooster Church by the locals.

(1) [Tip] How to take good pictures of Da Nang Cathedral!

Da Nang Cathedral is a must-take photo spot for Da Nang tourists. You can take a good photo from anywhere, but remember that you can take a photo from the statue of Mary on the right side of the main entrance of the cathedral, so you can see the cathedral at a glance. \times Due to local circumstances, it is difficult to tour the inside of Da Nang Cathedral. Please note that only 'external tours' will be conducted.











Son Tra - Son Tra, home to Vietnam's largest Buddha statue

Linh Ung Pagoda, located on Son Tra Peninsula, is a Buddhist temple with the largest statue of Avalokitesvara in Vietnam. The statue of Avalokitesvara is 67 meters high, equivalent to the 30th floor of a building, and the sunset sky and the lights on the statue make it look even more majestic. Across from the statue of Avalokitesvara, the panoramic view of Da Nang City surrounding My Khe Beach is spectacular.











Dinner - Local food(Seafood Restaurant)



Brilliant Seafood Restaurant, located in the bustling area of Danang near My Khe Beach, is a seafood restaurant famous for its stylish interior and excellent food taste. It consists of an open space on the first floor and a private room, and you can taste a variety of dishes such as grilled seafood, fried food, fried rice, and soup.

Danang Han River Cruise

Take a cruise along the Han River, which runs through the center of Danang, and enjoy the beautiful night view of Danang. In addition to the city lights reflecting on the river and the night view of Danang city, you will also enjoy various pleasures such as beautiful music and local traditional dance.












Vietnamese Traditional Massage - 120 minutes
