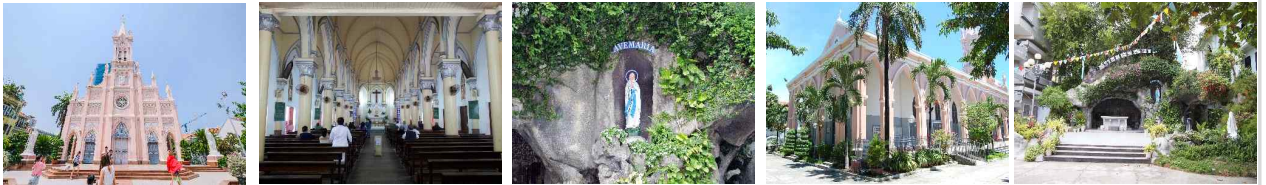
Da Nang city tour - Photo spots in Da Nang

Da Nang Cathedral(Pink Cathedral) - Da Nang's photo spots located in the heart of the city. It is a Catholic cathedral with medieval architecture built in 1923 during the French colonial period. There is a statue of the Virgin Mary in the cathedral yard, and because of its light pink exterior, it is also called the Pink Cathedral and has become a photo spot on Tran Phu Street. There is a rooster-shaped weather vane at the top of the 70m high spire, so it is also called the Rooster Church by locals.

[Tip] How to take good photos of Da Nang Cathedral!

Da Nang Cathedral, an essential photo spot for travelers to Da Nang, can be taken from anywhere, but remember to take pictures from the statue of Mary on the right side of the cathedral's main entrance, so you can see the cathedral at a glance.

✘ Internal tours of Da Nang Cathedral are difficult due to local circumstances. Please note that this is only an 'external tour'.



Son jja - Son Tra, home to the largest Buddha statue in Vietnam

Linh Ung Pagoda, located on the Son Tra Peninsula, is a Buddhist temple with the largest seawater Guanyin statue in Vietnam. The Seawater Avalokitesvara Statue is 67m high, reaching the 30th floor of the building. The sunset sky and the lights on the Buddha statue add to its majesty. Across from the Seawater Avalokitesvara Statue, the panoramic view of Da Nang city surrounding My Khe Beach is spectacular.



My Khe Beach - One of the world's top 6 beaches with long white sand

My Khe Beach is so beautiful that it was selected as one of the top six beaches in the world by the American economic weekly magazine 'Forbes'. It has an endless 10 km long fine sand beach. It is Da Nang's representative beach and is located close to the center, so it is a place visited by many travelers and also serves as a resting place for Danang citizens. There are many restaurants, cafes, and pubs nearby, so you can enjoy a meal or coffee while admiring the beach.

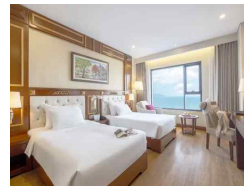

Lunch - local food, Bun Cha set meal (Must-Try Representative Food When You Come to Vietnam)



Bun cha is one of Vietnam's representative foods. It is a dish of meat cooked over charcoal, wrapped in vegetables and lettuce, and dipped in a traditional Vietnamese sauce called nuoc mam, along with noodles. Bun cha is a food unique to the Hanoi region, and thanks to its sweet and sour sauce and meatballs, it is also a Vietnamese food that best suits the tastes of Koreans.

Thu Bon River Tour - Admire the scenery along Hoi An's famous Thu Bon River

Enjoy the scenery of Hoi An along the Thu Bon River and visit a pottery village. The various ceramic products made in the pottery village are made using clay from the Thu Bon River and are sold throughout Vietnam.

Hoi An - Travel back in time, Hoi An (A city that retains its 17th century appearance)

Hoi An, a nearby travel destination that cannot be missed when traveling to Da Nang. Hoi An was a major port city on the Maritime Silk Road in the 16th and 17th centuries, and had exchanges with Asia and Western countries such as Portugal and France. It was formed as a district for Chinese and Japanese merchants who stayed at the time, and buildings remain throughout the streets. Although its reputation was lost when the trading port was moved to Da Nang around the 19th century, the elegance of the city center, where time seems to have stopped, and the traces of time have attracted travelers. The old town was designated a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1999.

This is a course to experience the history, culture, and lifestyle of Hoi An.

- ① In Hoi An, most tours are conducted on foot so that you can leisurely enjoy the streets.
- ② Hoi An is a place that looks great both during the day and at night! You can feel the charm of Hoi An Old Town, which is full of beauty every step of the way.



Naewongyo - Sights & Landmarks in Hoi An

This bridge was built by the Japanese who settled in the port city of Hoi An in the late 16th century to communicate with the Chinese. A residential area for Japanese and Chinese merchants was formed across Naewon Bridge, which was built in Japanese style and covered with a roof. It is now a landmark of Hoi An, both in name and reality, and can be seen on Vietnamese banknotes.

※ Naewon Bridge is currently undergoing repair work. It is possible to tour the inside of the bridge under construction, but please understand that it is difficult to view the exterior due to the construction cover facility.



Gwangjo Hall - A hall built by Chinese merchants in the past

Gwangjo Hall is a hall built by merchants from Guangzhou, China in late 1885. It combines Vietnamese architectural style with Jungung Guangdong style, and is dedicated to the god Guan Yu and the goddess Thien Hou, who protects ships for safe voyages. In the past, it was used as a resting place and a place for commerce for Chinese traders and sailors, and is currently used as a place for Chinese compatriots to meet and worship and as an altar.



Turnkey House - Hoi An's first old house designated as a UNESCO World Heritage Site

About 200 years ago, this was the home of a Chinese turnkey who was a tycoon in Hoi An. The 18th century mansion was well preserved and was designated as Hoi An's first UNESCO World Heritage Site. It was built using all Chinese, Japanese, and Vietnamese architectural styles, and the interior of the house is decorated with gorgeous antique furniture and decorations. Uniquely, there remain traces that show how high the river in Hoi An was when it flooded in the past. It was designated as a first-class old building by the Vietnam Cultural Heritage Administration, and is currently operated by Turnkey's 7th generation descendants.



Pungheung's House - The oldest house in Hoi An

It is the oldest wooden building in Hoi An and was built in 1780 by a business magnate named Pung Heung to sell goods. The two-story building combines a Vietnamese-style structure with a Japanese-style roof and a Chinese-style balcony. It is now used as a shop where you can purchase souvenirs and handicrafts.





Dinner - Hoi An set meal (Representative food of the Hoi An area to enjoy with a night view of Hoi An)



The three famous foods representing the Hoi An area are Cao Lau, White Rose, and Hoan Tan! Hoi An-style rice noodles called 'Cao Lau', which are mixed with thick rice noodles, pork, and vegetables on top of homemade soup; Hoi An-style dumplings called 'White Rose', named because the dumpling skin made of rice looks like a white rose; fried dumpling skin with tomatoes, onions, 'Hoan Tan', a Hoi An-style fried dish topped with minced meat. Enjoy traditional local dishes such as Hoi An's signature dishes, Morning Glory, and Cha Cho while admiring the beautiful Hoi An night view.

Cong Cafe - Vietnam's representative cafe with the concept of the Vietnamese Communist Party Cong Cafe is a cafe with the concept of the Communist Party and the Vietnam War, and its name also means Vietcong (Vietnam Communist Party). The overall interior and staff uniforms are all colored dark green, creating a unique atmosphere. It is considered a must-visit when traveling to Vietnam, and is so popular that it recently opened a branch in Korea. The signature menu item is Coconut Smoothie Coffee, which combines fragrant coconut, sweet condensed milk, and bitter coffee.

Guide meeting - It takes about 40 minutes by car to Banasan National Park.

After arriving at Banasan National Park, take the cable car

First take the cable car to the Golden Bridge and enjoy the fantastic scenery, then take the cable car again to the top of Mt. Bana and have free time.

Ba Na Hills Theme Park - Da Nang's representative attraction, a theme park located on the top of a mountain

Located about an hour's drive from downtown Danang and 1,487m above sea level, Ba Na Hills is a cable car station and recreational facility built by the French during the French colonial period. Take the 5,042m long cable car, which is registered in the Guinness Book of World Records, and enjoy the spectacular view of the forest-covered Mt. Bana. You will arrive at the summit in about 20 minutes. At the top, you can have a great time at the 'Golden Bridge', a huge hand-shaped sculpture that is Danang's landmark, and the 'Sun World Theme Park', which is reminiscent of an old European castle.

※ **Banasan Tour Information**

- ① The Banasan itinerary is conducted during free time.
- ② Lunch is not provided during free schedules.
- ③ Enjoy the fantastic view of Mt. Bana from the approximately 5 km long cable car heading to the top of Mt. Bana.

④ The summit of Mt. Banana is high above sea level, so the temperature is low, so it is recommended to bring a windbreaker or thin long-sleeved clothing.
