BOSS President Role, Skills and Responsibilities

- Assigned full-time to Garrison as the BOSS President
- Responsible for the BOSS Program under the guidance of the Garrison CSM and MWR Advisor.
- Promote and utilize the BOSS volunteer incentive program.
- Proficient in written and verbal communication.
- Conducts briefings to Soldiers, Commanders, and Directors.
- Ensures that BOSS Baseline standards meet.
- Effectively communicates with the Garrison CSM & MWR Advisor about the BOSS program ensuring both are up-to-date on all activities, issues, and concerns.
- Meets with the Garrison CSM & MWR Advisor on a regular basis.
- Leads all Installation BOSS Meetings.
- Prepares meeting agenda.
- Ensures meeting minutes, with attendance figures, are prepared and forwarded to the MWR Advisor and Garrison CSM for review, approval and signature.
- Leads the BOSS Executive Council.
- Plans, promotes, and executes recreation and leisure activities for single Soldiers, with the assistance & input of the Executive Council and single Soldiers.
- Ensures records of all single Soldier QOL, to include AFAP issues, are maintained, tracked, and reported in accordance with AR 25-400-2
- Oversee and ensure the proper utilization of the Volunteer Management Information System (VMIS) in accordance with the Army Volunteer Corps Program (AVCP) to include:
 - Ensuring all BOSS volunteers register and maintain records in accordance with AR 608-1, chap 5.
 - Tracking of all volunteer hours and ensuring that the BOSS Volunteer Coordinator has properly input all volunteer hours by the 15th of each month.
 - Reconciling all BOSS volunteer hours with Army Volunteer Corps Coordinator (AVCC) on a monthly basis. > Submitting a nominee for Installation Volunteer Awards (i.e. volunteer of the quarter or year)

- Ensures BOSS information is distributed, displayed, and marketed to all single Soldiers in a timely manner.
- Maintain continuity book.
- Maintain the BOSS garrison SOP annually.
