<input type="checkbox"/> HBB owners providing child care must register with the installation Child, Youth and School Services office as part of the Family Child Care (FCC) provider system.					
<input type="checkbox"/> The HBB owner is required to comply with and is subject to inspection by the appropriate city, county, state or federal agency, office or department for compliance with applicable laws, codes, regulations and requirements.					
<input type="checkbox"/> HBB's involved in food preparation may need to be approved by Army Public Health and/or the Local Health Department. The applicant must provide documentation that states the HBB meets all applicable food safety and sanitation conditions.					
<input type="checkbox"/> The residential character of the property shall be maintained. The HBB may not occupy more than 25 percent of the home's gross floor area. Parts or materials related to the HBB shall be screened from public view and will be limited to the interior of the structure or the side and rear yards of the property. Signage is limited to what can be displayed in a single window from the inside and may not be illuminated.

<input type="checkbox"/> Noise, vibrations, or odors shall not be detectable beyond the property line.					
<input type="checkbox"/> The HBB owner residing in privatized on-post housing must obtain approval to operate in writing from the community manager before submitting a request to the Senior or Garrison Commander.
