Essential documents for travel, simple guide, immigration information, and details.



1. Passport validity of at least 6 months
2. Round-trip air ticket: Have an outbound ticket within 30 days of entry.
3. Online Entry Declaration
 - * You must complete online registration starting 3 days prior to arrival in Taiwan and before immigration inspection.
 - * Failure to submit may result in delays in entry procedures or denial of entry.

Ximending - The Street of Youth and Movies

It is a bustling district, much like Myeongdong in Seoul, where shops and movie theaters are concentrated. There are many street vendors selling various foods and souvenirs throughout, making it fun to wander around. Furthermore, buskers and other artists frequently perform, allowing you to experience a different atmosphere every time you visit. Compared to the shopping district to the east, it feels more down-to-earth and attracts many students; due to the concentration of movie theaters, it is also known as "Movie Street."



Lunch - Taiwanese traditional beef noodles!



Considered a must-try dish in Taiwan, Beef Noodle Soup has been loved by Taiwanese people from the past to the present for its unique flavor, harmonizing with beef broth simmered with care over a long period. Don't miss out on trying this famous Taiwanese specialty!

Volcano 1914 - A hot spot filled with Taipei's vibe

Huashan 1914 Creative Cultural Park is a place that has breathed new life into dilapidated factories and breweries by transforming them into cultural and artistic spaces. It is a unique area filled with things to enjoy and see, featuring cafes, shops, and general stores with a vintage vibe and diverse atmosphere distinct from downtown Taipei.



101 Tower Observatory

The Taipei 101 Tower is undeniably Taiwan's tallest building and a landmark. Its unique exterior, resembling a stacked tower, is particularly impressive, featuring a bamboo-inspired design with segmented shapes on every eight floors. Taking the high-speed elevator, which was listed in the Guinness Book of Records until 2015, takes you to the 89th-floor observation deck in just 37 seconds. There is also an outdoor observation deck on the 91st floor. Ascend Taiwan's tallest skyscraper and fill your eyes with the beautiful night view of Taipei.

i Please note that access to the Taipei 101 Tower's 91st-floor outdoor observation deck may be restricted depending on weather conditions.

Raohe Night Market - Taiwan's Top 4 Night Markets!

Raohe Night Market, known as one of Taiwan's top four night markets, features cleaner food than other night markets and attracts a constant stream of visitors thanks to its affordable prices and diverse range of goods. It is particularly popular for offering many dishes that suit Korean palates. Must-try foods at the market include oven-baked dumplings, mango shaved ice, and beef noodles, allowing you to immerse yourself in the local culture and atmosphere.



Zhaogong - Splendid and magnificent Taoist temple

Songshan Ciyou Temple, also known as Zhaogong, was established in 1753 and boasts a history spanning over 200 years; it is magnificent and substantial in scale. Dedicated to the goddess Mazu, who assists people, the area along the Raohe River served as a fish market and a port for boatmen and cargo before the Raohe Night Market, located next to the temple, existed. It is said that the temple was built here to honor Mazu, the goddess who governs water. Throughout the temple grounds, one can see people earnestly praying with all their hearts.

Wulai Village - A hot spring village with beautiful mountains and water

Wulai Village, located about 30 kilometers from Taipei, is very famous for its hot springs. Originally a residence for the Taiya people, a minority of indigenous people, it has developed hot spring water and has become a tourist destination. Throughout the town, you can easily see facilities where you can enjoy hot springs and lodging together, similar to Japan. Wulai means "hot water" in the Aboriginal language, and it is derived from this and is called Wulai Village. This place is famous not only for its hot springs, but also for its very beautiful scenery, and the mountains that envelop Wulai create a serene atmosphere.



Wulai Cable car - Wulai cable car to the fresh world

Completed in 1967, the Wulai Cable Car is Taiwan's first cable car to the mountain on the other side, with a total length of 382 meters and a height of 165 meters. It takes 2 minutes and 40 seconds each way and can carry up to 91 people at a time. Unseon Paradise is often covered in fog depending on the day, making you feel like you are in a fresh world, and the experience of riding the cable car over the waterfall and crossing the beautiful foothills is the highlight of Wulai.



Yunxian Paradise - Taiwan's first amusement park overlooking Wulai Village

The Yunxian Paradise, which travels from Wulai to the cable car, is the first amusement park developed in Taiwan in 1967. As the name suggests, you can see a mysterious scenery that seems to be living in the clouds.

Stroll along the green forest stairs above Wulai Village and feel plenty of phytoncides.



Wulai Little Train - Little train to Wulai Waterfall

When you arrive at Wulai Station and cross the Lansheng Bridge, you will find a staircase to the Wulai Sightseeing Train platform on the opposite side, which departs from the Lamsheng Bridge at the entrance of Wulai and takes about 10 minutes to reach Wulai Waterfall for a total of 7 kilometers. This little train, which gives travelers to Wulai a special fun as if they were riding a toy train, arrives at Wulai Waterfall as soon as they get off at the end of the little train.

*The Wulai Little Train is non-operating on the first Tuesday of every month, and the schedule will be carried out by alternative means.



Wulai Old Street - A symbol of Wulai full of colorful sights and foods

It is an old street full of cute shopping streets and street food.



Wulai Waterfall - A beautiful emerald waterfall cascading from a height of 82 meters. It is a natural waterfall located in the Wulai area, and you can see the spectacular view of the waterfall falling down the rocks in three tiers. It offers a healing time to listen to the powerful and cool sound of the waterfall that contrasts with the tranquil natural scenery.



Lunch - Xiangben Steak



This is Xiangben Steak, a famous restaurant in Taipei where you can enjoy delicious steak.

Along with juicy steaks, a buffet featuring fresh salads, hot homemade pizza, and various fried dishes is also provided. Experience a happy meal from start to finish here, where ice cream and drinks are unlimited!

Yehliu Geopark - Yehliu Geopark, filled with uniquely shaped rocks

The rocks here have been formed into unique shapes by wave erosion and weathering over tens of millions of years, with massive egg-shaped rocks scattered here and there. Furthermore, the strangely shaped rocks created by the waves bear unique names, such as the Queen's Head (resembling a crown), Egg Rock, and Bathing Beauty Rock, allowing you to fully appreciate the sculpting artistry of the waves.



Shifen sky lantern flying - Let's send a wish into the sky, the highlight of a trip to Taipei - Sky Lantern Release at Shifen Station

Shifen is a place where you can experience "sky lantern flying," which has been featured in various media such as *Grandpa Over Flowers* and the Taiwanese film *Those Years We Loved*. Once a small, simple station on the old Pingxi Line, Shifen has gained fame for this activity. Shops selling various snacks and gifts line the railway tracks, and the place is always bustling with people sending lanterns into the sky with their wishes.



Jiufen - Jiufen Street, a famous spot for dramas and movies

Jiufen, once known as Asia's largest mining city in the 1920s and 1930s, has been reborn as a tourist destination utilizing its natural environment following the decline of the coal mining industry. Various shops, tea houses, and restaurants line the winding alleys along the hills. At the top of the village, known as 'Geding,' there is a spot where you can overlook the beautiful village and the sea at a glance. The famous peanut ice cream here attracts countless tourists, but please be sure to ask them to omit the cilantro, as it is included in the ice cream, if you do not like it.

Longshan Temple - Longshan Temple, the temple with the longest history

Founded in 1738, Longshan Temple is the oldest temple in Taipei, and its current buildings were reconstructed in 1975. The stone pillars are adorned with harmoniously carved dragons behind which dance figures, making the temple well worth a visit for its magnificent architecture alone. Here, you can experience the religious life of the Taiwanese people up close, accompanied by the rich scent of incense burned by devotees every day.
